


Uh oh...



I've had many friends and colleagues who are either licensed wildlife rehabbers or who spent summers volunteering with their local rehab facilities, that can attest to the dozens of animals that get brought in during the spring and summer by well intentioned folks who assumed that simply finding such a vulnerable baby meant it needed help. In many of these cases, these animals did not need help and now they'we been separated from their parents or mother and stand a much lower chance of surviving once they're released from the rehab facility. So how do you avoid making the same error?


